

Big Three Grammar Drilling

Snakes and Ladders – for two or more people.

Print the Big Three guide from anglais-facile.com, and a list of irregular verbs. You will need a dice and some coins to use on the board.

Cut the the Big Three cards out, shuffle them and put them in a pile.

How to Play

Throw the dice, and move your piece the appropriate number of squares. Take a big three(B3) card and change the verb according to the tense given. eg, you land on a square that says 'go' and you take a B3 with 'past simple positive – (you, they, we). Say out loud, '*you went, we went, they went*'. If the card says 'future question (he, she, it)' you would say '*Will he go? Will she go? Will it go?*' If you land on a ladder and you answer correctly, you can move up the ladder. If you land on a snake, and you answer incorrectly, you must slide down the snake.



















Solitaire version
